

LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27)

- (a) Beyond any fence or hedge bounding the course.
- (b) Beyond the inside line of any white post bounding the course.
- (c) The clubhouse and surround as defined by the cedar fence and white posts.

2. WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)

- (a) Water hazards are defined by yellow stakes.
- (b) Lateral water hazards are defined by red stakes.

3. ROADS AND PATHS

- (a) All artificially surfaced roads and paths (including woodchip paths) are immovable obstructions (Rule 24-2 applies).
- (b) All paths, which are not artificially surfaced, are integral parts of the course. The ball must be played as it lies or declared unplayable (Rule 28).

4. STONES IN BUNKERS

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions (Rule 24-1 applies).

5. PRACTICE PUTTING GREEN

The practice green behind the 18th green is a wrong putting green (Rule 25-3).

6. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS CLOSE TO PUTTING GREEN

Relief from interference by an immovable obstruction may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if a ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and an immovable obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief as follows: The ball must be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay that (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green. The ball may be cleaned when lifted. Relief under this Local Rule is also available if the player's ball lies on the putting green and an immovable obstruction within two club-lengths of the putting green intervenes on his line of putt. The player may take relief as follows: The ball must be lifted and placed at the nearest point to where the ball lay that (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids intervention and (c) is not in a hazard. The ball may be cleaned when lifted.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE

Match play – Loss of hole: Stroke play – Two strokes.

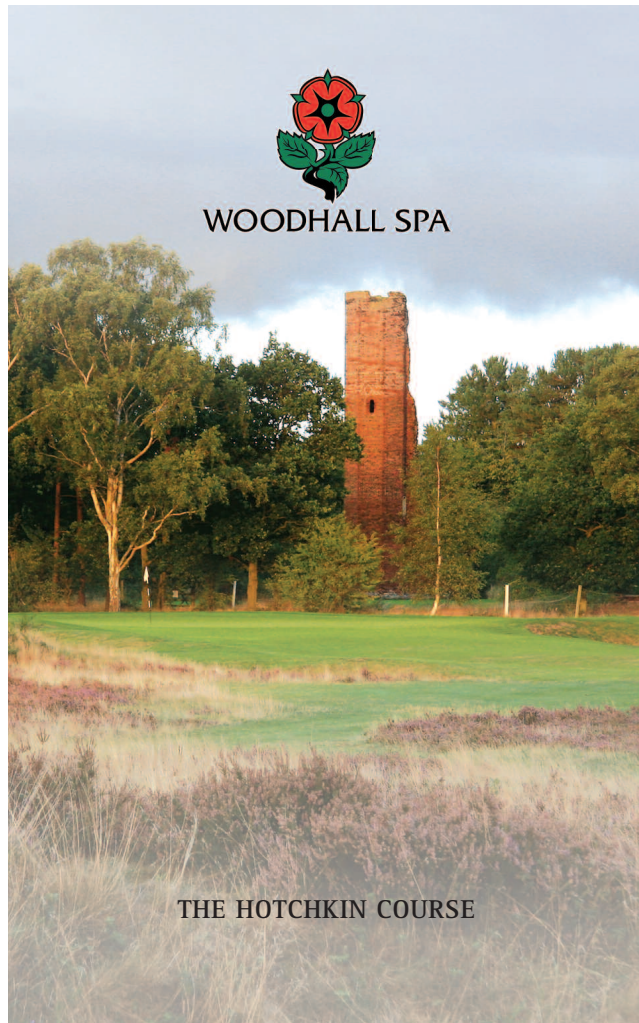
